

Summary of fund objective

The Fund aims to achieve long term capital growth through a concentrated portfolio by investing primarily in equity and equity related securities of companies listed on European exchanges. Up to 30% of the Fund's assets may be invested in Money Market Instruments, equity and equity related securities issued by companies or other entities not meeting the above requirements or debt securities (including convertible debt) of issuers worldwide. On 2 February 2024, a Luxembourg domiciled SICAV named Invesco Continental Éuropean Equity Fund was merged into the Invesco Pan European Focus Equity Fund, a sub-fund within the same fund umbrella.


Investment risks

Fund Strategy

At the core of the team's investment philosophy is a belief in valuation-driven, active management. The European equities team firmly believes that investors are best served by a focus on long-term investing, avoiding an over-emphasis on current trends and consensus. Companies operate in longterm cycles and so does the focus of the investment team's research. The team's approach is to take advantage of inefficiencies in the market and buy stocks at below what they believe to be their intrinsic value. The investment process is driven by fundamental stock-picking, combining both topdown and bottom-up analysis, and with a focus on valuation.





The Fund embeds an exclusionary framework to specific activities based on UN Global Compact, severe governmental sanctions, revenue thresholds for certain activities linked to environmental and/or social criteria, as well as ensuring that companies follow good governance practices.
